Message from the President Liliane Blom

Dear fellow artists and art lovers,

Hope you all have wonderful summer activities planned. I want to remind you that there will <u>not</u> be a June meeting. The board decided to save on rental costs as there had not been much of a turnout at the last few June meetings. I am however interested in knowing how you all feel about this. Also this is the last newsletter until the September newsletter, which you should receive at the end of August.

Our September meeting should be a lot of fun. We are planning an art material swap and social get together, so please bring your unused, old, not what you thought they would be; don't like them any more watercolors/acrylics/oils to the meeting. Why clog up your closet, basement or garage, bring your unused paper, frames, charcoal, pastels, pallet knifes and brushes with you and swap them for something else. It should be fun. Bring your business cards as well and make some new friends, we will have food and wine for you to enjoy.

Our May show looked great. I heard a lot of different things from our membership regarding the show. Someone opined that it was the best show RAL had ever put on, while others lamented the judges lack of interest in technical quality. I just want to remind everyone that they should never take rejection from a show personally. Judges opinions are always very subjective and a piece that is rejected by one judge, because of an ornate frame, might win a prize at the next show. A great way to get a sense for the judging process is to volunteer during the judge's selection process. It's very educational, and I would recommend it to all our members.

Here are the details for the hanging of the shows, thanks so much to Belinda Russell for organizing this. The info below is from Belinda:

Those of you who are submitting artwork to the June show at Visarts can leave it with me in the gallery 10am-3pm on Tuesday, May 31, or 10am-12pm on Wednesday June 1.

If you wish to make arrangements with one of the gallery guards to bring your work in after hours (e.g. 6-8pm on May 31) you may, but I will only be at the gallery at the above times.

Work will be hung on Thursday June 2, and any work that is not hung will be put aside in the storage room of the gallery for collection 1-3 pm.

I will ask that the gallery guards (RAL) have access to the storage room so that people can collect any of their unhung paintings during the evening or weekend gallery hours. I will be in the gallery on Saturday, June 18 and 25 from 3-5pm if you want to wait until then to collect unhung work.

We will change over from the June to the July show on June 29. July artwork needs to be at the gallery by then so please bring your work in Monday, June 27, or Tuesday June 28 between 10am-3 pm. June Artwork can also be collected at this time. Again, if you can't drop off during the day, you may arrange to drop it off in the evening with whoever is in the gallery, but final hanging of work will be Wednesday morning and afternoon.

After the July show, you may collect your work from me Thursday, August 4, 11am-2pm or in the evening 6-8 pm.

Students are introduced to methods of using multiple glazes over wet into wet passages to achieve an unsurpassed brilliance as well as the use of masking agents to achieve a jewel-like batik effect. David will show how to carefully construct a watercolor using sketches, tracing paper, photographs, and other materials. This workshop is for all who want to learn more about watercolor and the artist who wants to improve on their skills! David Daniels is the instructor for the Smithsonian Institution of Washington DC. He also teaches design and painting at Montgomery College in Rockville MD, as well as workshops around the world. His interactive approach and humor are often recognized as his strongest teaching tools. The heart of the artist and spirit of the medium are the two most important components of his teaching.
