Message from the President, Patrick Sieg

Greetings esteemed members of the Rockville Art League,

We are a few short weeks into the dates that members may enter their work for consideration in our RAL Juried Members' Winter Show. Lisa Sieg has pulled together important information about the call for entry is included later in this newsletter or by clicking here: http://www.rockvilleartleague.org/ral_wintershow%202022.pdf.

Please make time to read the show call before you enter your work and please do not miss our November 1, 2022, submission deadline.

Artist and professor Zdeno Mayercak will bring his perspective to the show as our juror. Please show him how talented you are by entering your best work.

Artist Glen Kessler was willing to share his approach to pricing artwork and we members know how hard it is to confidently price our work. His video was sent out on October 9th and is much appreciated.

We use a system titled Artwork Archive to collect entries, provide entries to our judge for the jury process, configure and print labels and present the virtual show that accompanies our actual exhibit at Glenview Mansion. We are lucky to have found this system and the more we use it the more we appreciate its functionality.

Some comments about the system:

- A personal link and password have been provided to every renewing member and fortunately many members have renewed. There is still time to renew if you haven't yet and plan to submit artwork.
- A good image of your work is vital. Your artwork image will be seen by our juror as he makes his selections and, if accepted, will be in the virtual show. We do not want to see your frame, your furniture, or any glare...just your artwork.
- The system has been configured to accommodate many needs for different types of organizations. Please don't worry about filling in everything as our league only needs certain information.
- o Required:
- A good image
- Medium used
- Dimensions: height and width. Sculpture will include the depth

- Price you are offering to sell your work. Please leave the price field blank if your piece is not for sale.
- Please do not input:
- A "wholesale price" as we do not want that, and it will not be on the label.
- Depth for 2-D work (that is only for sculptures).
- Creation date is optional and please don't make it "circa."
- Your birthday when updating any contact information...we don't need to know how old you are.

If your work is accepted, then please be sure it is professionally finished (framed or with painted sides of the canvas) and securely <u>wired</u> for hanging. Again, read the show call for details. Thanksgiving is the week before our artwork delivery date so please plan ahead.

And please contact Lisa or me if you need help using the system and don't wait until the last day.

I included the following in a newsletter prepandemic and it bears repeating...

"I believe the most important element when entering a juried art show is taking a risk and putting yourself and your artwork *out there*. Not every piece can be accepted in our exhibit due to the popularity of this show and space considerations. And not every piece that is accepted will win a prize. But every artist that believes in their work and is willing to share is a true winner. Entering our show is an act of generosity and a manifestation of the art spirit. "

November 3: Please join us on **Thursday**, **Nov. 3 at 7pm** on Zoom when we welcome artist and educator J. Jordan Bruns as he discusses *Japanese Influences: Three Years Abroad*.



Glen Echo Park Resident Artist, J. Jordan Bruns, is excited to present "Japanese Influences: Three Years Abroad" for the Rockville Art League on November 3rd. During his sabbatical in Japan, Bruns explored new methods of making artwork that were very different from his large-scale abstract paintings that were his comfort zone. Some of this work developed out of a small Japanese studio space, and some influenced by the new culture. Through the images shown in his discussion, he hopes to map his search for inspiration, and why he eventually settled on ink wash as his medium that reflects Japan.



J. Jordan Bruns is a full-time artist living and working in Maryland and a Glen Echo Park resident artist working in the Chautauqua Tower. He recently returned from a three-year sabbatical in Tokyo, Japan (2018-2021) where much of his current aesthetic influences stem from. In 2004, he received BFAs in Painting and Illustration at Maryland Institute College of Art. He then went on to earn an MFA in Studio Painting at Indiana University in 2007. After grad school, he instructed at and managed the Yellow Barn Studio and Gallery, at Glen Echo Park in Maryland. His love of teaching has led him to branch out and become Director of Art Clinic, a painting and drawing school at Glen Echo Park, Maryland in 2022.



His artwork is in the public collections of Novartis Pharmaceuticals and Kaiser Permanente. Solo exhibitions include Long View Gallery (Washington, DC) and The Indiana University Art Museum (Bloomington, Indiana). His numerous group shows include "Transient Geometries" at The Antelope Valley College Art Gallery (Lancaster, California) and "Color Schooled" (Long View Gallery, Washington, DC). His work has also been exhibited in Scope Miami in 2014, Context Miami in 2017 and 2018 as well as Aqua Miami in 2019 during Art Basel. For more information,

RAL Juried Members' Winter Show **DECEMBER 4, 2022 – JANUARY 2023 Glenview Mansion**

Call for entries: October 1 – November 1. Online submissions only.

Judge: We are honored that Professor Zdeno Mayercak will judge our Rockville Art League Juried Members' Winter Show. Members will remember his inspiring presentation in February about his work and journey as an artist and a sculptor over five decades.

Zdeno Mayercak studied Wood Carving at School of Fine Arts, Bratislava, Slovakia, and Figure Sculpture at Academy of Fine Arts,

Bratislava, where he received his MFA in sculpture. He also studied at the Academy of Fine Arts, Rome, Italy, under Prof. Lorenzo Guerrini. Zdeno came to the United States as a political refugee in 1985. He is currently teaching at Montgomery College where he is Sculpture Coordinator. He also exhibits his work internationally.

This juried show will be on display in person at Glenview Mansion Art Gallery (603 Edmonston Dr./Rockville) with the virtual show available on our website. Zdeno Mayercak will discuss the award-winning pieces on Thursday, Dec. 8 at 7:00pm on zoom. If protocols allow, this may be an in person walk-through as well.

Call Deadline: Members in good standing may submit up to 2 pieces of work for this show beginning October 1 until November 1 to be considered by the judge. No submissions will be accepted after the November 1 deadline. If your work is accepted into this show, you will be informed by Friday, November 11. Please read all the information below carefully.

Entry Fee: A \$10 show fee will be collected from *accepted* artists (not per piece).

Eligibility and rules: The following rules apply for all works entered.

- Each member in good standing may enter *up to two pieces* during the specified dates.
- How to enter: submit your entries beginning October 1 using your PERSONAL LINK and PASSWORD that was (or will be) emailed to you when you renewed. Please save this link to enter other shows offered this year. Submissions of up to 2 pieces per artist for consideration by the judge will be accepted by Tuesday, Nov. 1.
- For each submission you will be required to include: the title, medium, dimensions and market price (not wholesale price!) (if Not for Sale, please leave blank and you will be contacted to confirm this) and submit an image

- (jpeg or jpg.) of your piece. The mat or the frame (or glass, glare, wall, etc.) should NOT be visible in the image you submit. Just the artwork itself.
- If your work is accepted into this show, you will be required to **agree** to the terms of *the show* agreement below as well as pay the show fee.

Requirements: If your work is accepted into this show, *each 2-D piece must be ready for hanging*, gallery-wrapped or framed or professionally finished, **securely wired**.

- The maximum measurement of any framed side is 48 inches.
- Only original works <u>framed securely with</u>
 <u>hanging wire</u> are acceptable. (NO sawtooth hangers or such.) If submitting unframed canvas, edges should be painted or finished. <u>NO wet canvases</u> are allowed.
- The <u>entries may not have been exhibited</u> previously in a *RAL Juried Members' Show*. All artists are encouraged to sign their work on either the front or back.
- Entries not meeting the show conditions will not be accepted.
- RAL retains the right to determine suitability of work for entry in this show.
- All work must remain up until the end of the show.
- Sales: If any work sells while on display at Glenview, the artist agrees to donate 20% of the sales price to the City of Rockville.
- The Show Agreement: artists showing work at Glenview must agree to the following:

"I agree to the rules of the show as presented in the show call and the schedule below, that my entries are my original works and have not been accepted into a previous Rockville Art League Juried Members' Show, and I will not hold the Rockville Art League, Glenview Mansion, or the City of Rockville responsible for any possible loss or damage to my entries. As with any show, I understand that all reasonable care will be taken in the handling of my artwork. I give RAL, Glenview Mansion, and the City of Rockville permission to use images of my artwork and publish them as appropriate. I acknowledge a commitment to donate 20% of the sale price of my work, if sold during this show at Glenview to the City of Rockville."

- Best in Show (cash prize)
- First, Second, Third in all categories (<u>cash</u> prizes)
- Honorable Mention at Judge's Discretion

- October 1 November 1 online submissions (up to 2 pieces per artist)
- Tuesday, November 1 deadline for all submissions
- **November 11** notifications of acceptances sent out by this date
- TUESDAY, Nov. 29 delivery of accepted artwork at Glenview, 10:00am-1:00pm
- Sunday, Dec. 4 1:30-3:30pm, *Meet the Artists* Opening at Glenview Mansion (optional)
- December 8, 7pm Zdeno Mayercak will discuss his choices of the award-winning pieces on zoom. If protocols allow, this may an inperson walk through as well.
- TUESDAY, January 17: pick up artwork 10:00am-1:00pm

Please note: members in good standing will be emailed their personal link by October 1. *If you paid your dues for Sept. 1, 2022 – Aug. 31, 2023*, you are a member in good standing. PLEASE: if you are unsure of your membership status, ask us! If you cannot find your link, please ask. Use it to enter your work in the show. Be sure to type in all information

carefully and clearly. This information will be used to contact you and to create the virtual show and the labels.

If you need help, please ask ahead of the deadline!

You may enter work for this show beginning on **October 1.** Deadline for all entries is **Tuesday**, **November 1**.

If your work is accepted into this show, you will be notified **by November 11.**

About the show *Alone*, *Together*: The pandemic shook humanity to its core. The Montgomery Art Association is a nonprofit supporting the visual arts and artists in Montgomery County and the D.C. metro area.


Several RAL members are also MAA members and have work in this memorable show.





Annapolis. The show runs from November 2 - 26. You can view the entire exhibit online at https://mdfedart.com/exhibitions/.






Gloria Miotto has a solo show *Mosaic of Life* at Bender JCC's Goldman Art
